As a leader and a man of God...

Clearly articulate God's history of personal and universal faithfulness to His people. (1-13)

Challenge people to make <u>a decision</u> to <u>serve</u> the Lord. (14-28)

Live your life as a <u>living testimony</u> of God's faithfulness until your <u>last breath.</u> (29-33)

## Questions for Discussion:

What would you include in the story of God's faithfulness to His people down through history?

Why do you include what you do? Why don't you include what you didn't include?

What would you include in the story of His faithfulness to you personally?

When did you make your decision to serve the Lord?

What was the occasion? What prompted you to make such a commitment?

If you haven't yet made that decision, what is keeping you from doing it - right now?

What would be different in your life after having made that decision?

What steps do you think are vital to "finishing well?"

How well are you carrying out these steps?

What do you think most people base their identity on?

What is necessary to resist such temptation and base it on being a "servant of the Lord?"
