Questions

- 1. What is a CADRE? How is being in a group that is designed for obedience and mission different than a Bible Study or community group? How could growing in obedience be helpful for you and others around you? How could living on mission grow you closer to Jesus Christ?
- 2. What does it mean to Look Back? Why should a CADRE start by giving thanks? What happens when believers begin to thank God for all He is doing? How does that grow your faith?

- 3. What is loving accountability? How does this differ from what many people consider accountability? What would it look like to encourage and challenge another believer? Why is this so important? Why is this so challenging?
- 4. What is the mission of BRAVE? Where is it derived from? What does it mean *To Challenge BRAVE Warriors for Courageous Kingdom Advancement?* How is that statement aligned with Matthew 28:18-20? Why is it important for a church to know its mission? How does a CADRE change when everyone knows why it is meeting?
- 5. What does it mean to Look Up? Why do we need to spend time seeking Jesus? Why do we start with the Word of God? Why are we there to learn? What attributes are needed to learn? How are humility and being teachable essential in a CADRE? What does it mean to state the verse? Stick to the passage? Speak in sentences? Why is this so important?
- 6. What does it mean to Opt in? What is SPEC? Why is it important to know if there is a Sin to avoid? Promise to claim? Example to follow? Command to obey? How does this help us understand who God is, what God is doing and what God expects?
- 7. What does it mean to Grow? Why is it important to see areas of your life where you may need to apply this passage of Scripture? How does being aware of the different areas of your life help you grow in your faithfulness to God? How is learning, opting-in and growing different than just learning from a teacher?
- 8. What does it mean to Look Forward? Why is it important to have a specific area to be obey? Why is listening to the Lord and sharing that area of obedience with your CADRE so important? Why is it important to make your "I will...." Statement specific? How will this result in loving accountability the next week? How can SMART goals help? Specific, Measurable, Attainable (Achievable), Realistic and Timely? How is this different than a generic statement of obedience?
- 9. What does it mean that we are going to SEND others on mission? How are we called for PRAYER, CARE & SHARE every week? How can we grow in our prayer times, prayer walks and prayer moments? How can we grow in our CARE through words, works and wonders? How can we be ready to share the 3 circles?
- 10. How does the simplicity of the CADRE model help us to grow in obedience and mission for Jesus? What benefit does personally growing in obedience to Christ and his mission have for us as believers and for the lost around us? How does having a clear, simple, biblical and replicable format help us in making disciples?
- 11. What is keeping you from going through Membership? What is keeping you from CADRE Orientation?
- 12. What is your greatest take-a-way from this week's message? What do you need to apply right now in your life?
