We welcome without judgment because
Jesus Christ <u>consistently modeled</u> welcoming without judgment. (36-38)
A <u>partial</u> welcome and a judgmental spirit is the heart of a <u>religious hypocrite.</u> (39)
Jesus Christ <u>welcomes us</u> in the <u>brokenness</u> of our sin. (40-47)
Only through <u>faith in Christ</u> can your sins be forgiven. (48-50)
