

Sermon Questions

Revelation 19

This week we discussed four reasons that we can say *Hallelujah* based on Revelation 19. Sometimes we consider *Hallelujah* a word that should only be said in a church service; however, we learned that we can *Praise the Lord* at any time because He is always so worthy. As the scene unfolds for how Christ will quickly engage in the final battle of Armageddon it thrills our heart to see our Lord and King defeating his enemies; not to mention the fact that we will have a front row seat! This encouraging text from the book of Revelation should provide a clearer picture of Jesus Christ and who we truly worship. May the Lord give you insight as you continue to meditate on this passage.

Here are some notes to review from this week's sermon...

Raise a Hallelujah

Revelation 19

Raise a Hallelujah because Christ the Lord...

Our God, the Almighty, reigns...Hallelujah (1-6)

Makes His bride ready...Hallelujah (7-10)

Uses His Word to strike down the nations as His armies watch...Hallelujah (11-16)

Inflicts punishment on the unholy trinity...Hallelujah (17-21)

Questions

1. What does the word *Hallelujah* mean in any language? When and why should we praise the Lord?
2. Why should we praise the Lord for our salvation? For His glory? For His power? Why should we praise the Lord because He is faithful and true? Why should we praise the Lord for His justice in punishing sin? Why should we praise the Lord that His dominion is everywhere? Why should we praise the Lord that He is reigning?

3. How powerful is it that the bride has been made ready for the marriage supper of the lamb? Who is the One that makes the bride ready? What is the significance of Jesus Christ being the One who makes the bride ready?
4. What is the difference between us making ourselves ready versus Jesus Christ making us ready? Explain the difference. How does our belief in our identity in Christ differ from our commitment to change? Can we change ourselves? If we cannot change ourselves then how do we allow Christ to change us? Can you give an example from your own life?
5. What is the testimony of Jesus Christ? How important is the Word of God to the testimony of Jesus Christ? What did Jesus testify in His words and actions? What did Jesus Christ testify to through His death, burial and resurrection?
6. How is your life a testimony of Christ's testimony? Why is our testimony so important? Why is the testimony of every believer so important? How is Christ's testimony and our testimony of Him the spirit of prophecy? In other words, how does Christ's testimony and our testimony proclaim the truth to people in the world?
7. How does the picture of Jesus Christ portrayed in Revelation 19:11-16 differ from many understandings of Jesus Christ today? Why is the picture so important for our world to recognize? What is the title of Jesus as He sits on a white horse? Why are the words *Faithful* and *True* so fitting for our Lord?
8. What do you notice about Christ body and the way He is dressed in this scene? Describe Him. Why is His robe dipped in blood? How significant is it that Christ has already been battling His enemies and that they have deceived into believing they can gather together to defeat Him? How long will the battle of Armageddon last? What will be the result? What will be your point of view during this battle?
9. What will be your responsibility in the battle of Armageddon? Who is the one who does ALL the killing? How does Christ kill all of His enemies? What weapon does He use? How powerful is the Word of God? Why must the Word of God be elevated in your life? How can you trust the Word of God more in your life? What habits have you created or could you create to allow the Word of God to dwell more richly in your heart?
10. What will happen to the antichrist and the false prophet when Jesus Christ engages in this final battle? What is the significance of these two men being thrown *alive* into the lake of fire? How long will they be in the lake of fire?
11. What happens to satan at this final battle? What will a world look like when satan has no authority and power? Describe what that millennium will be like when there is no temptation to sin?

12. What happens to all of those who followed satan, the antichrist and the false prophet? What benefit is there to forsake Jesus Christ? Is Jesus Christ your Lord? Are you a follower of Christ? Testify to your small group how Jesus Christ is your Lord.
