## 2. God's sovereignty demonstrates His involvement in the smallest of details of our lives.

How does your life demonstrate a belief that God is really in control of everything? Have you experienced circumstances in your life that caused you to question God's sovereignty? If so, what was it? How did you respond?

## 3. God's compassion yearns for more people to worship Him.

How does your life demonstrate a passion for lost people to worship Jesus? What are you passionate about in life? Where does a passion for the lost rank in your list? Do you know how you would share the gospel with a non-Christian if given the opportunity? How would you?

## 4. God's mission for the world is primarily accomplished through His people.

How does your life demonstrate a primary alignment with God's mission to reach people for Jesus? What is your understanding of God's mission?

What Scripture passages would you point to as a basis for it? What is the difference between being compliant vs. being "100% full in?"

What percentage would you say you presently are?

What are you holding back from God?
