Betrayal Defined: Attempting to demonstrate <u>outwardly fervent</u> actions toward Jesus Christ while maintaining an <u>adulterous heart.</u> (47-49)

God uses betrayal for good when you respond by/with...

Humility. (50)

Trusting His <u>power</u> and <u>presence</u> presently. (50-53a)

Following His Word regardless of outcomes. (53b-56)
