BIG IDEA: "God's Spirit puts my discouragement to death and fuels my fight against sin."

Dealing a death blow to discouragement in our fight...

- 1. My victory is certain. (v.1-4)
- 2. My disposition is secured. (v.5-8)
- 3. My <u>future</u> is <u>set</u>. (v.9-11)
- 4. *My <u>fight</u> is <u>supported</u>.* (v.12-13)

Four Characteristics of Our Fight against Sin...

- -We fight AS A FAMILY
- -We fight BY THE SPIRIT
- -We fight WITH DILIGENCE
- -We fight FOR LIFE
