1. What does it mean that God is omniscient? How does that differ from just being very smart?
2. How does it make you feel to understand that God knows all things? How intimately acquainted is God with your speech, actions, and motives? Why would God spend so much time thinking about us?
3. What does it mean that God is omnipresent? How does that differ from being able to be in the right place at the right time?

4. How does David respond when considering God's knowledge of all things, including himself? How should we respond to God in His understanding and awareness of all things? Of us?
5. Where could you go to escape from God? Where is God? How long has He been there? What feelings do you have when you consider that God is everywhere?
6. What does it mean that God is omnipotent? Who has more power than God? What is too powerful for God?
7. When you consider God's power on a macro-level, what is overwhelming to you? When you consider God's power on a micro-level, what is overwhelming to you?
8. What is too difficult for God to accomplish? What is beyond the scope of God's power?
9. Since God is all-powerful, all-knowing, and in all places, what does God have the ability to see when He looks at an "unformed substance" in a womb? Who is the creator of life? When does life start? Who decides when life ends? When does God decide on our number of days?
10. What does it look like to have overwhelming gratitude? Can you think of a situation where you felt overwhelming grateful? Why should we feel this way about God?
11. How should we be growing in our passionate zeal for the Lord? Why is God's holiness so important for us (as His children) to understand? Why was David so passionate about God's reputation?
12. Why is it important for us to be continually yielding to the Lord? How does God want to shape us? How can we allow for God to shape us? What could God accomplish through you if you would allow for Him to shape you?
