Big Idea: God proves his love by paying the price of the promise

- 1. Do you love anything more than God? (1-4)
- 2. Will you worship God even when you don't know what he is doing? (5-6)
- 3. Do you believe God will provide? (7-8)
- 4. Do you see the <u>significance</u> of the <u>substitute</u>? (9-18)

Questions for Discussion:

Has God ever tested your love for Him?

If so, how did He do it? What was the result?

Are you currently being tested? What will it look like for you to "pass the test?"

Is there something or someone you love more than God?

If so, what/who is it? What will it look like for you to place it/him/her on the altar?

Have you ever experienced a time when you were confused about what God was doing? If so, what was happening? How did you respond? What did you learn from the experience? Are you currently confused about something God is doing? What will it look like for you to worship Him in the midst of it all?

Have you ever experienced a time when if God didn't come through you were in a hopeless situation? If so, what happened? What did you learning about God through the experience? Are you currently waiting on God to come through for you in an important way? How well are your worshipping now? Is there any way your worship should change?

Have you ever doubted God's love for you?

How does God providing a ram in place of Isaac which foreshadowed God providing His Son in your place help clear up any doubts of His love?
