

Sermon Questions

Revelation 14

This week we studied chapter 14 of Revelation and learned some of the promises God makes as things get difficult at the end of this age. It's very important for you, as a believer in Christ, to be centered on God's Word and His promises so that the enemy doesn't cause you to live in fear. God allows and will continue to allow Satan a rebellious spirit for a period of time. However, that time will be short-lived and God will have His way as He has promised from the very beginning. As saints of the Lord may we persevere in our faith and continue to seek God's face.

Questions

1. Why does Jesus put His Name and the Name of His Father on the heads of the 144,000 Jews? What is the significance of God sealing the 144,000 Jews? Why is it important that these 144,000 are sealed? What does this sealing demonstrate about God's protection?
2. What do you notice about the character of the 144,000? How serious do they take the holiness of God? Why? How should you also live like the 144,000?

3. Read Ephesians 1:13-14? Have you been sealed? By whom have you been sealed and for what purpose? What confidence should this bring to your life as a believer?
4. What is the Gospel? Why is it important that the Gospel is proclaimed? Will the Gospel always be proclaimed in the world?
5. What was the message of the first angel? What does it mean to fear God and give him glory? What does it mean to worship Him? Why is this a central component to the Gospel? Is this the way you are currently hearing the Gospel proclaimed? Why or why not?
6. What does the second angel proclaim? What does it mean that Babylon the Great is fallen? Why will all the religions of the world ultimately be seen as false? Why is Jesus Christ the only way? What kind of immoralities does Babylon the Great cause the world to do? Why must this be punished?
7. What does the third angel proclaim? Why is worshipping the antichrist and taking his mark tragic? What will the outcome be for those who worship the world's geopolitical system? What will these people experience?
8. Is hell a real place? How long will torment in hell endure? Why is it important that we understand the significance and reality of hell? If hell is real why don't we hear more preachers teach on this reality? Why have some pastors and teachers neglected this teaching?
9. Will Christians ever experience God's wrath? Why or why not? What was the significance of what took place on the cross? How was God's wrath satisfied?
10. Why are Christians called to persevere? When you suffer and go through trials and tribulations why should that be comforting (see Acts 14:22b)?
11. Who will help the genuine believer to persevere? Why should this be comforting to the believer? Why should this be troubling to the pretender?
12. Do you truly know you are born again? How do you know? Share your testimony with your group.
13. How certain is the fact of God's judgment of the righteous and the unrighteous? Why is it significant to understand that God will right ever wrong and reward all the righteous?
14. What is your greatest take-away from Revelation 14? What does God want you to apply today in your walk with Him?
